The Pierce County PACT team has openings for advisory board members to help provide stakeholder feedback related to service to clients served by the PACT team. The group is also charged with offering support, guidance, assistance, and advice to the PACT team, to help ensure fidelity to the PACT model. The group advises and monitors on issues of consumer complaints or grievances, as well as on consumer rights. Meetings are quarterly at the PACT office and terms of membership are a minimum of one year.
